### 4 NEW JOHN DEERE 6R SERIES TRACTORS ANNOUNCED!

**Go smart, do more!**

Since their launch in 2011, **John Deere's 6R Series tractors** have set standards in both field and transport performance as well as precision ag technology. With 14 new generation models from 110 to 250hp announced last month, these tractors have become even smarter to help operators achieve even more.

To meet individual customer requirements, the 6R Series has been extended by 4 new tractor models. Chief of these are the compact and efficient 6R 185 that delivers up to 234hp with IPM and is specially designed for transport work, plus the 6R 150 with a four-cylinder engine and high payload, which is the perfect all-rounder for mixed farms.

#### **New features include:**

- Integrated 1-Click-Go AutoSetup system, which makes tractor and implement settings much quicker and easier
- Optimal operator comfort with all settings and indicators on the corner post display
- E-joystick, which is particularly useful for front loader work
- A dynamic weighing system that allows weighing on the move
- A new Starfire receiver which will offer even more precision ag performance and superior signal stability
- IPM (Intelligent Power Management) has been made smarter - this includes additional horsepower in hydraulic applications as required. The four-cylinder models can now deliver up to 20hp and the six-cylinder models up to 40hp when using hydraulic fans, pumps and the most power-hungry hydraulic implements, eg wrapping balers, slurry tankers and drills

Another highlight of the latest 6R Series tractors is their new design. The hood and mirrors are well known from John Deere's larger tractor series, while the name and numbering system has also been adopted from the 7R, 8R and 9R Series models. The 6R range name is now followed by a separate indication of the rated engine horsepower.

## MAZZOTTI UPDATES SELF-PROPELLED SPRAYERS

Mazzotti's MAF range of self-propelled sprayers have recently been updated and extended. A fully-owned subsidiary of John Deere operating from its base in Ravenna, Italy, Mazzotti focuses on building self-propelled sprayers that offer high customer value

The existing MAF 2580 (2500-litre capacity), 3180 (3000-litre) and 3580 (3500-litre) models now feature multiple upgrades, including a new solution system, new wider range of spray booms, John Deere spray controls and a new John Deere-sourced operator station. Larger 5,000 and 6,000 litre machines were also introduced in the spring.

The MAF range sees the addition of a new compact high-capacity machine, the MAF 4080. This features a chassis with a longer wheelbase to enable the larger 4000-litre solution tank to be carried, while maintaining the ideal 50/50 weight distribution achieved by the smaller MAF models.

A new range of MK spray booms from 24 to 36m wide, including a triple-fold 36/24m version, are now available for Mazzotti MAF sprayers. Featuring a triangulated 3D steel construction and with the stainless steel spraylines protected within the structure, they are built for durability and a long working life.

Individual Nozzle Control (INC) for fast and precise switching of each individual spray nozzle is fitted as standard, again utilising an INC system developed and manufactured by John Deere. For manual operation virtual section widths can be specified from the cab, while in auto mode each nozzle is switched individually according to DGPS positioning.

The spray control system now exploits John Deere ISOBUS technology, providing a powerful but easy to use interface. A choice of John Deere 4240 or 4640 GreenStar displays provide full control of the spraying process, and with the addition of an optional StarFire 6000 DGPS receiver they can also take care of individual nozzle control, prescription applications and job recording.

## JOHN DEERE LAUNCHES BIGGEST EVER TRAILED SPRAYER



John Deere's new R975i sprayer is the biggest trailed model the company has ever produced. This 7500-litre machine will join the rest of the R900i Series line-up, with tank capacities of 4400, 5200 and 6200 litres, in 2022.

As with other sprayers in the range, this new model benefits from John Deere Precision Ag technologies, enabling customers to profit from additional smart solutions. The R975i is designed to meet customer requirements for larger tank volumes and wider booms, as well as higher accuracy, reduced chemical use and more comfort when filling and operating the sprayer.

The machine's new larger volume will mean farmers and contractors can spend more time in the field spraying, and so increase productivity by covering larger areas with one tank. The proven PowrSpray dual-circuit solution system also helps to speed up filling times, improves spray application and increases accuracy.

For the first time on John Deere sprayers, the M900(i) and R900i Series models will offer 25cm nozzle spacing as an option. This is an 'On Centre' solution that means an additional nozzle is placed between each 50cm nozzle body on the spray boom. John Deere has also added a nozzle body plus an additional nozzle at each end of the boom to offer full coverage and eliminate underdosing at the boom ends.

All trailed sprayer ranges will also benefit from the options launched on the R700i Series for 2021. These include Individual Nozzle Control, which limits over- or underdosing to help preserve yields while saving input costs. Nozzle Control offers savings in crop protection products worth up to £4/ha\* on top of Section Control.

Another feature is the new Closed Transfer System, which is an ISO approved coupling. This prevents contact with and any spillages of crop protection products, to ensure filling the sprayer is safe for the environment as well as the operator.

Calculated for a 500ha farm growing wheat, with a herbicide cost of £39/ha + fungicide cost of £48/ha – 5% saving on £87 = £4.3/ha

## BENACRE FARMS WITH THEIR NEW JOHN DEERE S685i COMBINE

We joined Benacre Farms during harvest to find out how they were getting on with their new combine!

*"Benacre are a big estate that grow many acres of crops including cereal and potatoes. Our tractors have been supplied by Ben Burgess for almost 20 years now, including our John Deere 7530 and 8370, both of which are very reliable machines. My favourite machine is the 8370 which, with its suspension, is excellent on the road and is a good all-round tractor. It pulls a large Sumo Versadrill with 8 legs on the front with ease."*

*"We were running a Claas Lexion 740 combine but we had a little accident with that last year, so decided to buy a John Deere S685i combine in March 2021. I must say I'm impressed! I never thought I'd say that about a John Deere combine."*

*"Previously I had been against John Deere combines as about 10 years ago we had tried the first John Deere CTS, when it first came out and thought the machine wasn't there yet as they had I felt rushed it onto the market, so we kept with our Claas combine, but even after driving the S685i for just three weeks, I'd now recommend it to anyone! We changed from the Claas Lexion 740 model to a John Deere S685i combine; mainly because you get more for your money. It has a simple design so there's less to go wrong and the machine runs clean (we don't have to blow it down every day) which is a good advantage."*

*"We have now had the chance to run the machines side-by-side and the S685i has more than doubled the output of the Lexion, which would do just under 20 tonnes per hour on barley and the S685i has managed 42 tonnes per hour which is very impressive. The grain losses were down with the S685i too. I think our area sales manager Ben Conway was a bit shocked when he came to see me and I said I loved it. I don't think I would turn back now."*

*"We also run all our machines using a Greenstar guidance system, meaning we can track them all on a single device. It makes life so much easier and if there are any problems, we know we only need to ring one point of contact - Carl Pitelen at Ben Burgess for help with our tech."*

*"The thing that made Ben Burgess stand out for us over the years is their continued level of service and support. # JOHN DEERE HAS EXPANDED IT'S COMMERCIAL ZTRAK RANGE

John Deere's commercial ZTrak ZTR zero-turn mower range has now been expanded to include two new petrol models, rear-discharge decks and mulching options to meet customer demand.

Offering a high-output yet compact solution for grounds care professionals, particularly when working in restricted spaces, John Deere zero-turn mowers are based on a robust, heavy-duty frame including a ROPS. The high-gauge PRO steel rotary cutting deck feature a deep mowing chamber designed to handle more grass for increased capacity. 
